About Pack 45

Pack 45 is based in Hanover, NH and in the 2011-2012 school year it had 23 cub scouts and 5+ leaders. The pack is sponsored by the Hanover Lions Club and is part of the Daniel Webster Council in NH.

We are fortunate to have experienced leaders who have been Cub Scout leaders for several years and some are also Eagle Scouts themselves. Our leaders are dedicated to making scouting a fun, educational, and rewarding experience for your son and your family. Our pack stresses qualities such as respect, honesty, teamwork, and camaraderie.

While our focus is on providing a fulfilling scouting experience for our boys and their families, the area and state scouting organizations also offer many family-oriented events as well, such as family campouts and outings.

Meetings

Pack meetings are generally the first Friday of the month at 6:00 PM (subject to the Ray School schedule). Den leaders will setup their den meeting schedule for at least once each month. We always try to avoid conflicts with soccer, baseball, skiing, and other activities when possible. Sometimes the meeting will be at the Recreation Center in Hanover, at a parent’s home, at Storr’s Pond, or at a “go see em” location. (e.g., fire station, recycling center, etc.).

Dues

New Cub Scouts are asked to pay \$13 for the last third of the year, and after that all Cub Scouts are asked to pay for a full year in January (\$50 for Tiger, Wolf, and Bears, and \$75 for Webelos). These fees cover their Cub Scout registration, subscription to Boy’s Life (the boy’s scouting magazine), and the remainder covers some of the Pack 45 costs such as their books, badges & outings.
